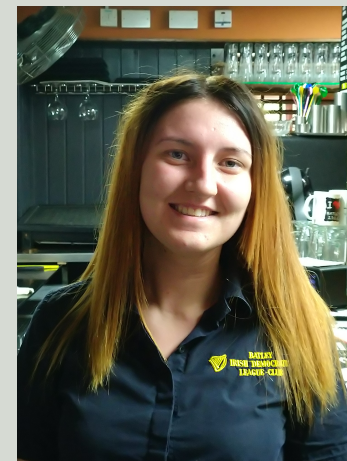
Phase I Complete

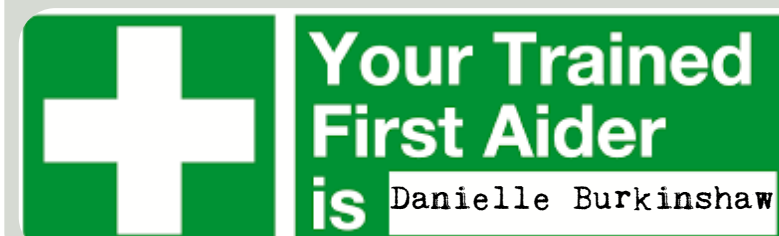

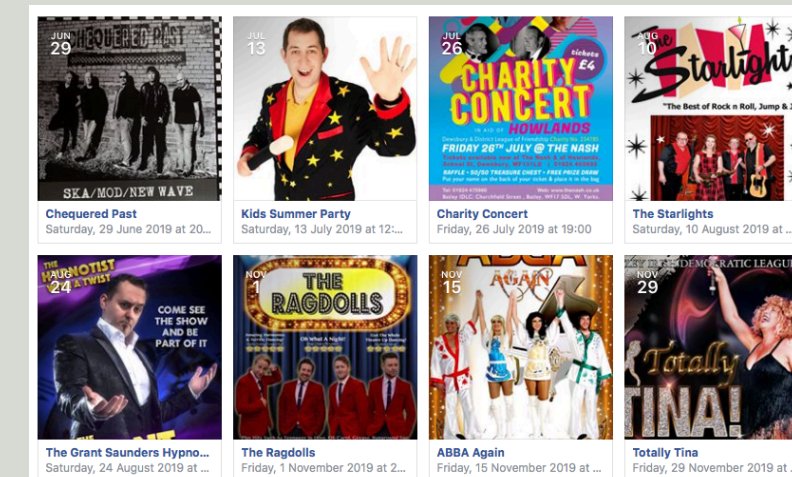
New Pilsner is a hit!
